PUBLIC HEARING – NYS (CDBG) COMMUNITY PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM

The public hearing is for the village board to have residents assist the Village in defining community development priorities and to assist the Village in identifying possible activities for inclusion in an application for NYS CDBG Community Planning program funding. The Village is planning to submit an application for a NYS CDBG Community Planning Program Grant in response to a Notice of Funding Availability issues by the New York State Office of Community Renewal.

Motion by Trustee Harvey to close the public hearing and resume the regular meeting at 2:02 p.m. was seconded by Trustee Davis and carried with all voting aye.

Mayor Wood said there was a good meeting held the previous night at the Masonic Temple for the Shared Services. There were 28 in attendance. Darryl Heiby will hand surveys out to Rotarians for them to complete.

Residents in the Euclid Ave, Walker Road, Lake Ave and Davis Tract area are not cooperating in returning the income survey for available grant funding (Small Cities) that is income eligible. Trustee Laraby suggested contacting Ruth Lavin, a Euclid Ave resident, to assist in having residents return their survey.

Motion to adjourn meeting at 2:16 p.m. was offered by Trustee Laraby, second by Trustee Davis and carried with all voting aye.
