

**VILLAGE OF PERRY
VILLAGE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING**

JUNE 14, 2013

The Special Board Meeting of the Village of Perry was held at the Village Hall 46 North Main Street Perry New York at 12:00 p.m. on the 14th day of June 2013.

Mayor Hauser called the Meeting to order at 12:00 PM and introduced Patrick Gallivan, our district NYS Senator.

Senator Gallivan took a few moments to thank former Mayor Howard Wood for his helpfulness and understanding. Then Senator Gallivan presented Howard with a Proclamation that was signed by both the NYS Assembly and Senate thanking him for his service.

The Senator said that he intends to stay in touch with the area concern and be the people's representative. He did announce that there are no more member items, at this time. He did suggest that if municipalities have a need for something, to put their request in writing so that it may be put on a list if there is monies available somewhere; but cautioned officials not to count on it.

Senator Galvan then spoke on several different topics:

- Tax abatements. He is very supportive and hopes that the state can move forward on statewide tax abatement. He will try to move it to the floor for a vote with assistance from a Long Island representative.
- A & A Metals (Brownfield site) has been totally remediated.
- Local Government Efficiency Grants – The Town & Village of Castile have applied for this to rebuild a joint municipal building.
- SUNY Attain Lab – Stated that this was handled terribly from the start. There is a commitment for funds until the end of the state fiscal year (until April 1st).

Steve Tarbell, Castile Town Supervisor, spoke about a sub-committee meeting he attended on local Economic Development (Canals/Parks/Rivers). There could be funds available towards the Walker Road Bridge, dredging the outlet and the Silver Lake Outlet Trail. He is to put together a presentation, along with Jim Brick, for a July 1st meeting to promote positive things and expand use for possible funding.

PMSA – Sandy Schneible presented Senator Gallivan with a packet of information from PMSA. She spoke on different ideas that PMSA is working on.

Discussion over which region Perry/Castile/Silver Lake belongs to; Niagara Area Region or part of the Finger Lakes Region. Wyoming County is in between them.

Discussion took place concerning the SUNY Attain Lab. A summary of events regarding the funding and operation of the lab was reviewed.

Mayor Hauser explained to everyone in attendance on the Main Street LLC program's that he has been involved in and their function. He said that these work on multiple levels and demand is there.

Motion to adjourn meeting at 1:17 p.m. was offered by Trustee Jacobs, second by Trustee Billings and carried with all voting aye.
