SILVER LAKE TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY



PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Genesee Transportation Council (GTC) and the Village of Perry are conducting a feasibility study for the Silver Lake Trail. The study will develop and evaluate alternative route scenarios for a multi-use trail that would connect Letchworth State Park and the Genesee Valley Greenway to Silver Lake via Silver Lake Outlet.

The Silver Lake Trail corridor offers the potential of providing active transportation alternatives, healthful recreation opportunities, access to historical resources, economic development, and improved connectivity to the evolving regional trails network.

The study will consider safe alternative trail alignments, project feasibility issues, planning level cost estimates, realistic project phasing and a practical implementation plan for the project.

PRELIMINARY PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- » Enhance safety for pedestrian and bicycle travel in the Perry area.
- » Improve alternative transportation connections between Wyoming County communities and two State Parks.
- » Promotion of the Perry area as a tourist destination for visitors to Letchworth State Park.
- » Establishment of the first multi-use trail in Wyoming County outside the State Parks.
