The Village of Perry is in the process of developing a Complete Streets policy that will provide guidance and direction to new development projects at the site plan review stage, ensuring they contribute to and enhance the existing public realm we all call home. In addition, a policy will position the village favorably to receive grant funding for future projects related to accessibility and streetscape improvements, health, safety, wellness, and physical activity.
