VILLAGE CLERK'S OFFICE REMINDERS

2023-2024 Village Taxes

Tax bills will be mailed on May 30, 2023 and due by July 3, 2023 without penalty. Payments will only be accepted by mail or in person at the Village Clerk's Office or online at www.villageofperry.com. Payments will no longer be accepted at M&T Bank.

Alarm Permits

No person shall own, use, lease, operate or maintain an alarm system without obtaining a permit from the Village Clerk's Office. The fee for an alarm system permit is \$25 and expires yearly on May 31st. Please refer to the Village's code, [Chapter 150: Alarm Systems](#) for more information or contact the Village Hall.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

The route for **bag and brush pickup** will begin on May 1st and on the first Monday of every month thereafter. The route may take a few days to complete.

Paving of Walnut Street will begin on Monday, May 1st and should be completed by the end of the week.

As a reminder, please **do not mow grass clippings** into the street. It creates dangerous conditions for walkers, bikers, and drivers and clogs up the storm drains.

PARKS DEPARTMENT

The Village of Perry owns and operates several parks: Perry Village Park – 120 Lake St, Park Ave – 21 Park Ave, Memorial Park – 64 S Main St, and the Perry Beach. The hours for the parks are 6am – 11pm. To help maintain the quality and appearance, we ask that there is no parking in the grass and to follow the Village's policy of carry in/carry out for all Village parks.

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PROPERTY MAINTENANCE STANDARDS & ENFORCEMENT

As we enter the spring season, here are a few reminders of the Village's property maintenance code, [Chapter 465-14](#).

Every structure and accessory structure shall be kept structurally sound and in a state of good repair to avoid safety, health, or fire hazards.

The exterior of all premises shall be kept free from hazards, which include but are not limited to:

- Garbage, solid waste, trash, hazardous waste.
- Unsafe structures.
- Discarded appliances.
- Natural growth.
- Overhanging objects.
- Ground surface hazards.
- Recurring accumulations of stormwater.
- Infestation.
- Nuisances.
- Inoperable vehicles.

The Perry Police Department and Zoning Officer will enforce the provisions of the law and the property owner will be notified of the violation. If after notification and failure to remove, said removal will be made by the Department of Public Works, and the cost of such removal will be charged and assessed against the owner.

NEW YORK STATE LOW INCOME HOUSEHOLD WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHWAP)

The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) helps low income households pay the cost of water and sewer services and can assist households with past due bills. GARBAGE POLICY

Garbage and recycling totes are to be placed near the roadway for pickup on the day before or day of pickup only. Since 4/1/2021 the Village has been enforcing chapter 465 section 14 of the Village Code (which can be found at www.villageofperry.com). Removal of garbage by the Village will result in fees.
